Beirut – Damascus – Beirut

- Pick up at a time & location of your choosing in Beirut, Lebanon.
- Transfer to the Syrian border by private car for exit/entry formalities.
- Start a walking tour of the old town through the narrow alley ways.
- **Azem Palace** (a perfect example of a traditional Damascene house turned museum of the Ottoman times)
- **Umayyad mosque** (a place of worship since the first millennium B.C. It was once a church and now one of the most unique and important mosques in the world).
- Lunch in a local Syrian restaurant.
- Walk through **Al-Hamidiyah Souq** – the city's largest market.
- Stop for tea in the **Khan As Pasha** – a huge caravanserai which was once a central meeting and trading place for travellers.
- Time depending – optional visit to the National Museum of Syria.
- Explore the Handicraft market for some of the best handmade goods in the Middle East.
- Drive back to Beirut. (Transfer to Amman is \$50 extra)
- End of Damascus Tour.
